WES 2013 Abstract Submission

- Environmental Engineering Education As climate change affects more individuals and industries worldwide, training in the relatively new field of Environmental Engineering is now crucial.
- **Environmental Policies** While businesses can step up to the plate, it still takes policies to entrench meaningful efforts.
- **Food and Water Security** Two of the most important issues in our changing world, without which everything else is as good as moot.
- **Financing Climate Change Opportunities** Money does make the world go round and much needs to and has been committed to the environmental cause by big and small companies.
- **Innovative and Sustainable Technology** Technology must keep pace with the everchanging demands of the world.
- **Integrated Environmental Management Systems** With so many practices, no single system is applicable or appropriate for all situations.
- Natural Disaster Mitigation and Management One of the tragic outcomes of climate change is more and harsher natural disasters for which all nations must prepare.
- **Professional Ethics and Conduct**: Key Prerequisites for Sustainability To attain and maintain sustainability calls for clear ethical and professional standards.
- **Sustainable & Innovative Development** If we are to protect the environment, development can no longer be business as usual but must be sustainable.
- **Sustainable Energy** The energy question is always important and much discussion has gone on and will continue to go on.

Authors can submit a one page abstract here beginning June 1, 2012. All abstracts must follow the prespecified format and if there are more than one author per abstract, at least one must be registered.

The Abstract Review Committee comprising of experts from various fields will evaluate and screen the abstracts, and make recommendations for inclusion in the Summit programme. The authors of the accepted abstracts will then be invited to submit full papers for presentation at the Summit. All decisions of the Committee will be final. The deadline for abstract submission is **February 28, 2013**.

Authors of technical papers selected for presentation will be able to register to attend WES 2013 at SGD960.00 (*valid for 4 days of the Summit, subjected to prevailing Goods & Services Tax, if applicable*). This rate is only applicable to one author per paper selected.
