RESOLUTION OF THE ANTI-CORRUPTION STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE WORLD FEDERATION OF ENGINEERING ORGANISATIONS

- 1. The Anti-Corruption Standing Committee of the World Federation of Engineering Organisations (WFEO) welcomes and supports the initiative of the British Standards Institute to develop and implement BS 10500 (the specification for an anti-bribery management system).
- 2. The Committee believes that BS10500 will be a very useful tool which can help organisations demonstrate that they have implemented effective anti-bribery controls.
- 3. The Committee recommends that:
 - a) BS10500 evolves as soon as possible into an ISO Standard.
 - b) Public sector procurement bodies require companies tendering for public sector projects to be compliant with such a standard.
 - c) BS 10500 should be widely translated into other languages.
