# 1. INTRODUCTION

This report to the WFEO Executive Council gives an outline of the activities that the Committee on Disaster Risk Management (CDRM) has performed from October 2021 to October 2022.

# 2. BRIEF BACKGROUND

The WFEO during its General Assembly held in Italy in December 2017 approved that the Peruvian Engineers Association (CIP, *Colegio de Ingenieros del Perú*) became the chair of the CDRM for a period of four years. The CIP requested the renewal of the CDRM mandate for a new four-year term and this was approved at the WFEO General Assembly held in Costa Rica in March 2022.

# 3.1 Preparation of the strategic plan for CDRM 2022-2025

# 3.2 Launching of the book on Resilience in English version

On May 5 at 7:30 am (NY time), the conference Engineering Resilience in Disaster Risk Management for Sustainable Development was held. It was a side event to the Seventh Annual Multi-Stakeholder Forum on Science, Technology and Innovation for the SDGs. WFEO-CDRM, CIP, UNESCO, ISC and ASCE joined forces to organize this event. About 100 people from different parts of the world participated in the event.

# 3.4 Organization of international webinars

CDRM working groups, with the support of the Secretariat organized four international webinars, with the aim of adding more case studies and new discussions to those already developed in the book.

Some CDRM members participated as speakers in these events. Several external specialists were also invited to participate.

In the organization of these events, in some cases, WFEO national members (Engineers Australia, Ghana Institution of Engineers, The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, Science Council of Japan and Institution of Civil Engineers) were involved, as well as UNESCO.

The events were broadcasted in Spanish and English, and managed to attract between 100 and 200 participants from different parts of the world.

#### 3.6 Call for new members

As agreed at the CDRM annual meeting on 25 February this year, members who do not renew their membership would be removed from the committee.

So, the committee has added new members representing WFEO member nations, as well as leading experts from major research institutions. CDRM has members from the five continents.

# 3.7 Coordination meetings

On 24 June, Dr. Marlene Kanga and the CDRM chairman had an online meeting with Dr. Rashmin Gunasekera, senior Disaster Risk Management specialist and leads the Global Program for Disaster Risk Analytics at GFDRR/World Bank, to exchange information on the activities of each institution, to explore possible interactions on subjects of common interest, and to invite him to join the CDRM as a member. Dr. Gunasekera nominated his colleague James Daniell to join the committee.

On 8 July, CDRM received an invitation from the International Coalition for Sustainable Infrastructure (ICSI) to participate in a global consultation to collect views from members of the engineering community on topics related to the implementation of disaster risk management, resilience and sustainable development in the built environment. This is with the aim of developing a Policy Paper representing the views of the global engineering community to feed into the mid-term review of the Sendai Framework. Interviews were conducted, as well as a survey in Spanish and English was circulated among CDRM members and other specialists.

On 22 August, the chairman of WFEO-CDRM met with Dr. Davide Stronati, Chair of the All Committees' Chairs board committee, in order to report on the organization and development of CDRM activities, as well as on the opportunities of inter-STCs collaboration, and challenges ahead.
