Abstracts should clearly state the subject matter, the objectives, and the important conclusions to be presented in the full paper. The abstract should include the title of the paper, the author's name and the affiliation including the mailing and the e-mail addresses. Selection of papers will take into account the originality, relevance and likely interest to delegates. Theoretical papers are expected to include experiments or practical validation and/or detail of likely application. Guidelines for the submission of manuscript for review and for the preparation of final draft will be communicated upon the acceptance of the abstract. Abstracts should not exceed 400 words. Paper manuscript or power point presentations are both accepted. Speakers whose abstracts have been accepted will be exempted from the registration fee.



- 6) Each exhibitor is entitled to one full conference package one person allowed to attend all the technical sessions free of charge during the 3 days conference period.


