  - Needs to be solution oriented and just on the problem; need to document the results so the solution could be shared
  - Peru workshop feedback and what to do; is this a potential focus topic

  - Something around the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of WFEO
  - How to Increase the Number of Women Engineers on Boards
    - Presented information that ties in to this topic (per Ania)
  - How to Promote Women Engineer's Accomplishments
    - Engineers Girl
    - Women engineers you should know
    - Story mapping (per Nancy)
    - women engineers pioneers (per Maryam)
  - o Keeping Women in a Technical Career Path (PhD's, technical experts, published papers, etc.)
  - o Including Men in the Equation for Increasing Women in Engineering
  - Women engineers who want to work but can't or are working below their capabilities
  - Consider something virtual to make it more accessible for others globally
  - o Focus on SDG goals around engineering versus specifically women
  - This should be a marketing campaign so that we have the visibility as a group and we identify as one group
  - Lack of engineering toys for girls; anyone on the committee can wrote a letter to the toy
    manufacturers that Valerie could send to the toy manufacturers
  - Could we work with the WFEO education committee to move some of these education issues forward
