#### **Current State of WIE**

Quickly reviewed current themes (where to find them), membership, and communication

#### **Improvement Opportunities**

Since we had a small group in Amsterdam, we took the opportunity to discuss areas of improvement, specifically in the following areas:

- Communications
  - Official = Distribution list (will be updated shortly)
    - For in country events, send information to Valerie and Stacey and they will share on the distribution list
  - o Sign up for WFEO Flash on the WFEO web site
  - Stacey to work with Valerie on how we get in country events shared on the WFEO website
  - WhatsApp to be used for informal communications
  - Pull out specific articles to include in WFEO Flash
- Member Engagement and Strategic Alignment
  - o Establish focus topic for the year from within the WIE 3 Themes
    - What is the problem we are all trying to solve
    - Set the focus topic as the goal for the year
    - Establish this in Rome for 2018
    - Conduct at least one event in 2018 around that theme
      - Adapt the theme for what works in your region or country

- Potential Focus Topic needs to be solution oriented and just on the problem; need to document the results so the solution could be shared
  - How to Increase the Number of Women Engineers on Boards
  - How to Promote Women Engineer's Accomplishments
  - Keeping Women in a Technical Career Path (PhD's, technical experts, published papers, etc.)
  - Including Men in the Equation for Increasing Women in Engineering
  - Women engineers who want to work but can't or are working below their capabilities
- o More recognition
  - Pick 3 best practices from the submitted committee reports and have them report in Rome meeting
  - Recognize people who have officially confirmed their membership status
- Acknowledgement of various women's days on website or email chain or something else
- Ways to drive consistent action year round
  - o Consider Skpye meetings or other virtual committee meeting throughout the year
  - Establish agenda for the year
